Greens Update 13 November 2020

Bunker on 14th now filled, turfed and completed, area will be GUR until ready to use.

Drainage work in progress on both 14th and 17th greens to prevent puddling which has been developing in the past few weeks. All holes on the 18 hole course and most on the 9 hole course have been verti drained.

Traffic management measures have been put in place around the course. Please help minimise damage to vulnerable areas of the course by adhering to all of these measures.

It was expected that we would have had new practice nets in place by now. However our contractor has informed us that the lockdown in England is impacting the supply chain of materials required to complete this project. We are in regular contact to ensure that this project is completed as soon as possible.

All greens currently being cut once per week.

Reminder: Still an unacceptable number of pitch marks not being repaired (I repaired at least 4 on every green last Saturday), please repair at least one pitch mark on every green, if every member did this then our greens will continue to improve.

All fairways on 18 hole course were divoted last Sunday.

Bushes and scrub cut back and trees trimmed in area between 4th and 5th Fairways.
