Top dressing will take place on Monday/Tuesday with overseeding later in the week. Unfortunately, this is essential work which needs to take place in dry weather to be most effective. Please accept my apologies for any inconvenience which this might cause.

Some positive news (hopefully). Having played at Largs recently I was impressed by the simple solution which they have used to ensure normal holes are used on greens. This has therefore been implemented for this weekend which will hopefully be well received. Remember not to touch the pin!
